Right to information:

Right to rectification:

If your data is incomplete or incorrect, you can have it corrected or replaced at any time. request their completion.

Right to erasure:

You can request the deletion of your data if they are being processed unlawfully or Processing interferes disproportionately with your legitimate protection interests. Please note, that there may be reasons that prevent immediate deletion, e.g. in the case of legal regulated retention requirements. Irrespective of exercising your right to erasure, your data will be deleted immediately and completely, unless there is a relevant one legal or statutory retention requirements.

Right to restriction of processing:

You can request the restriction of the processing of your data if

- you dispute the accuracy of the data, for a period that enables us to verify the accuracy of the data.
- the processing of the data is unlawful, but you refuse deletion and instead request a restriction of data use,
- we no longer need the data for the intended purpose, but you still need this data

- need to assert or defend legal claims, or
- you have lodged an objection to the processing of the data.
